RULES

All races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, and the Laser Class rules where applicable, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and/or this event's Sailing Instructions. Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration. One race constitutes a regatta. Six races are scheduled. There will be one throw-out if six races are completed.

CLASSES

Three boats are required to form a class. The Regatta is open to all boats of the The Regatta is open to all boats of the Laser Standard, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 classes. Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each class will be awarded. Additional awards may be awarded depending on competitor turnout.

ENTRY

Eligible boats may be entered in this regatta by [completing a registration](#) with the Vancouver Lake Sailing Club in accordance with the [regatta registration form](#). A boat must be registered and have all fees paid to VLSC before becoming an official competitor. Five boats must be registered in each fleet in order to be scored separately. Awards will be given to the first 3 finishers in each fleet.
